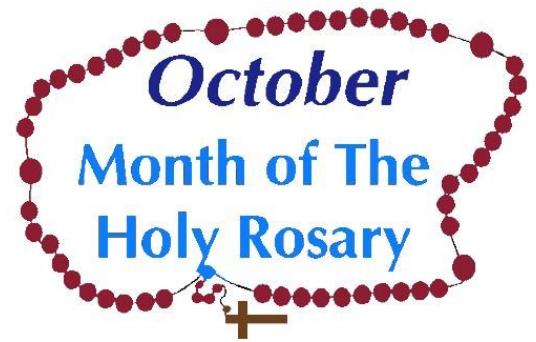

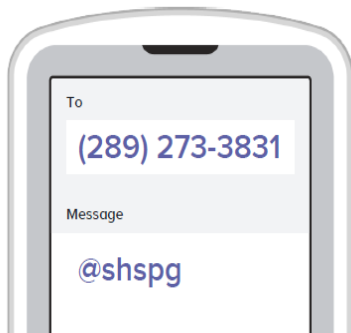

Photo retakes will take place in October. Be sure to wear a clean uniform and bring your best PANTHER Smile!

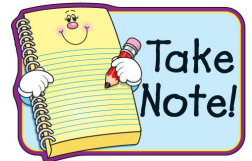
## TUITION AND SUPPLY FEE PAYMENTS

## ELECTRONICS



Electronics are not allowed on school property. (e.g.: iPods, DSi games, etc.). If a phone or other device is brought to school for after-school safety, it is your child's responsibility to hand it into the classroom teacher. Electronics that are not turned in will be taken away and will have to be collected from the school office. As well, we ask that no toys (stuffedies, Lego, action figures, trading cards or alike) be allowed to leave the safety of your home. Lost or broken items are difficult for everyone; special treasures need to be left at home. Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

## HOMEWORK DURING ABSENCES

If your child(ren) will be missing school for more than one consecutive day, missed work will be prepared for pickup 24 hours after the initial advice of absence is received. This will allow teachers time to properly prepare materials for pickup.
