Student Textbooks and Library Books: Please ensure that your child/ren have turned in all of their school textbooks before the last week of school. Year-End Field Trips: Planning for year-end fieldtrips is well underway. Permission slips with information about individual trips are always sent home prior to the event. These slips must be signed and returned to the school before your child can leave the school property. Please make note of the upcoming events for your child—be sure permission slips are signed and returned to the school including payment as required—and be sure your child has the supplies/gear they need for their field trips. **Also, if parents/guardians wish to volunteer, a police record check must be on file at the school office. If you will be driving, a driver's abstract along with a copy of your insurance and driver's license are required on file.** Many thanks to our volunteer parents!!

Dress Code Reminder: As the weather warms up please be reminded of our dress code—PLEASE label your child's belongings! 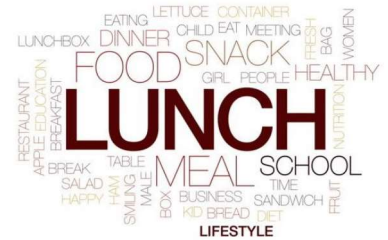
