Dear Parents/Guardians,

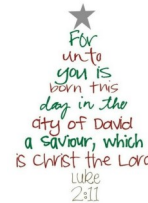
Happy Advent to you all! This season is such a wonderful time to spend with the students as we prepare to celebrate Christmas.
