

TUITION AND SUPPLY FEE PAYMENTS

Many thanks to those who have paid the supply fee, as well as the September tuition. We appreciate your attention to these necessary details. Arrangements can still be made to have automatic debit/credit payments set up; please contact the office for the forms.

ABSENTEE NOTES

If your child is going to be absent from school, it is imperative that you excuse the absence with the office; this is crucial to the funding we receive through the Ministry of Education. Please remember to **email** the school before 8:30am when your child is going to be absent or late—otherwise we will be phoning contact numbers on file to ensure their safety. **An email sent to sacredheart@cispg.ca will cover both the phone call and note!**

ELECTRONICS

Electronics are not allowed on school property. (e.g.: iPods, DSI games, etc.). If a phone or other device is brought to school for after-school safety, it is your child's responsibility to hand it into the classroom teacher. Electronics that are not turned in will be taken away and will have to be collected from the school office. As well, we ask that no toys (stuffies, Lego, action figures, trading cards or the like) be allowed to leave the safety of your home. Lost or broken items are difficult for everyone; special treasures need to be left at home (Exception for Kinder's Show & Tell on Fridays). Thank you for your understanding in this matter.

HOMEWORK DURING ABSENCES

If your child(ren) will be missing school for more than one day, missed work will be prepared for pickup 24 hours after the initial advice of absence is received. This will allow teachers time to properly prepare materials for pickup.
