School Start Pre-Packaged School Supplies

We have partnered with School Start this year for the option of purchasing school supply packs for the 2025-26 school year. Packs will be delivered directly to the school before the first day of school. Please check out our website for the link and instructions for ordering from the School Start Website, as well as school specific classroom supply lists if you prefer to purchase the required items yourself. Watch for a note in the students' final summative report card on their class placements for 2025-2026.









Summer Olympics: Our All School Summer Olympics Day will take place on Monday, June 23rd from 10:00am to 2:00pm.

Student Textbooks and Library Books: Please ensure that your child/ren have turned in all of their school textbooks before the last week of school. Payment will be required for any textbooks issued at the beginning of the school year that are not returned or that are damaged beyond use. Thanking you in advance for your prompt attention to this matter. As well, please check for any library books that may still be in your house and return them by June 13th - we really need these back in the school library for next year!



<u>Medication:</u> Please remember that if you have provided prescription medication &/or OTC drugs for your child, they must be **picked up by 11:30am on June 26th**.

<u>Year-End Field Trips:</u> Planning for year-end fieldtrips is well underway. Permission slips with information about individual trips are sent home prior to the event. These slips must be signed and returned to the school before your child can leave the school property. Please make note of the upcoming events for your child—be sure permission slips are signed and returned to the school including payment as required —and be sure your child has the supplies/gear they need for their field trips. <u>Also, if parents/guardians wish to volunteer, a police record check must be on file at the school office. If you will be driving, a driver's abstract along with a copy of your insurance and driver's license are required on file. Many thanks to our volunteer parents!!</u>

School Class Photos: Class photos were taken on May 14th. Each student will receive a class photo at the end of the school year.

<u>Dress Code Reminder:</u> As the weather warms up please be reminded of our dress code—PLEASE label your child's belongings! Navy or white collared shirts are expected - T-shirts are NOT an acceptable shirt to wear. Navy blue shorts may be worn but must cover the thigh; hats are permitted while outdoors. NO open-toed shoes, flip flops or open sandals are allowed for your child's safety.
