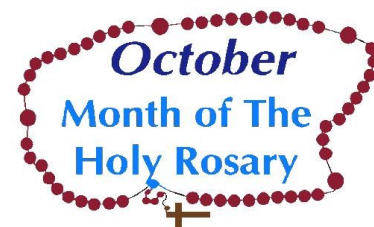

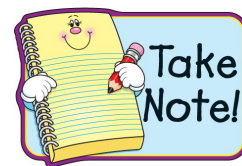

ABSENTEE NOTES

If your child is going to be absent from school, it is imperative that you excuse the absence IN WRITING with the office; this is crucial to the funding we receive through the Ministry of Education. ELECTRONICS



Electronics are not allowed on school property. (e.g.: iPods, DSI games, etc.). If a phone or other device is brought to school for after-school safety, it is your child's responsibility to hand it into the classroom teacher. Electronics that are not turned in will be taken away and will have to be collected from the classroom teacher. As well, we ask that no toys (stuffedies, Lego, action figures, trading cards or the like) be allowed to leave the safety of your home. Lost or broken items are difficult for everyone; special treasures need to be left at home (Exception for Kinders' Show & Tell on Fridays). Thank you for your understanding.

HOMEWORK DURING ABSENCES

If your child(ren) will be missing school for more than one day, missed work will be prepared for pickup 24 hours after the initial advice of absence is received. This will allow teachers time to properly prepare materials for pickup.


